I am a true believer that Badminton is for Everyone, of all ages, abilities and backgrounds. When people become better at their sport, they invest more time and effort into it.

In an ambitious way I see the role of Coaching & Development should:

1. Create a systematic pathway to help players identify their current position, and be able to set targets for where they want to be;
2. Provide work opportunities for top coaches to come to the Dome- this in return will attract high end competition players;
3. Develop a suite of development classes to suit all ages, abilities – making Dome an open and welcoming place and boost member base;
4. Provide support to young adults in obtaining their Level 1 and level 2 BE coaching qualifications.
5. Create more beginner and practice clubs to help new players grow confidence in their games;
6. Actively interacting with Junior Club coaches at the Dome, understand what support they need to expand grassroot` for the future.
7. Actively interacting with adult clubs; introduce the developing players to them as new members.
8. Fundraise for special projects – such as Disability badminton, children with autism/learning difficulties or from less privileged backgrounds.
9. Establish a network with other coaching communities and clubs in Middlesex / West London for friendly matches and socials.
10. Increase badminton population and promote a healthy living and equality concepts for players and their families in the local communities
